









#### Why is the Regional Water Planning Process Important?


- Funding
  - o TWDB (grants & loans) requires "consistency" with State and regional plans
  - o SWIFT funds require projects be in the Plan
- Permits
  - o TCEQ (water rights) requires "consistency" with State and regional plans
  - o Groundwater Conservation Districts some districts require "consistency"
- Provides picture of the overall water supply situation for the State
  - o Education of the public
  - o Education of the Legislature
  - o Dialogue regarding appropriate water supply strategies







- October 14: Submit Final Plan





Water User Groups


### Water User Group Plans

- Presented on a county basis
- All use types will be presented
- Only WUGs with needs or those showing strategies are included in the presentation
- Needs = shortages from Supply/Demand comparisons









# Wholesale Water Providers

# Wholesale Water Provider Plans

- Contracts to sell wholesale water
- Not already a WUG
- Needs = shortages from Supply / Demand comparisons
- Supplies:
  - $_{\circ}\,$  Own sources GW and SW
  - o Purchased sources
  - $_{\circ}\,$  Constrained by capacity to treat or deliver
- Demands:
  - o Contractual obligations
    - Full contract amount
    - · "Meets" contracts
  - $_{\circ}\;$  Supplies for strategies of others
- Will be coordinated between now and 12 Feb
