City of Riesel Waiver of Consistency Request

Background

- City of Riesel experiences high levels of arsenic (naturally occurring)
 - EPA's MCL 10 ppb (2010), was 50 ppb
 - Riesel supply routinely exceeds 10 and can be as high as 32 ppb
- Riesel plans to utilize the Brazos River Alluvium as a source to blend and dilute arsenic concentrations – Riesel Area Arsenic Reduction Project
- Brazos River Alluvium not identified as a potential source for Riesel in the 2016 or Initially Prepared 2021 Plans
- Riesel has applied for TWDB funding but is ineligible
- Riesel requests Brazos G support for a waiver of consistency with the regional water plan to allow them to pursue TWDB funding

Proposed Project

- One new water well
- Maximum annual planned use: 306 acre-feet
 - City of Riesel
 - MS Water Supply Corporation (McLennan County-Other)
- Modeled Available GW (McLennan County): 15,023 acre-feet
- Total MAG allocated (McLennan County): 5,777 acre-feet
 - o irrigation, mining, manufacturing
- Remaining MAG available: 9,246 acre-feet

"The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group supports the Texas Water Development Board granting the City of Riesel a waiver of consistency for developing the Riesel Area Arsenic Reduction Project, and authorizes the Brazos G Chairman to send a letter of support to the Texas Water Development Board."

Background

- October 14/15, 2020 letters to Brazos G from Cameron and Stephenville
- Cameron pursuing new pump station on Little River
 - Project needs to be protected from flooding
 - Constructed above 1 percent chance flood (100-yr)
 - Protected from the 0.2 percent chance flood (500-yr)
 - No existing Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for this stretch of the Little River
 - Cameron has requested Texas Flood Infrastructure Fund (FIF) funding from TWDB
 - Watershed study to establish 1.0 and 0.2 percent chance flood elevations
- Stephenville pursuing FIF funded flood study grant for the Green Creek-North Bosque" watershed, which covers most of Erath County
 - Will provide regional flood information for use by more than just Stephenville

Similar Requests from Both Cities

- TWDB application process requires applicants identify potential participating entities within the project watershed
- Cameron and Stephenville both invite Brazos G to participate
- What's expected? Brazos G would provide:
 - Readily available flood related data
 - Historical flood damage information
 - Identify flooding hotspot locations
 - Comments on the study
 - Help disseminate information to the general public
- The FIF is a new program, and we should expect more of these requests

Proposed Action


"Option 1. The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group supports the Cities of Cameron and Stephenville in their efforts to develop flood studies in their areas, pursuant to the Texas Flood Infrastructure Fund Category 1 Watershed Studies (FIF Program)Brazos G will consider participation with the FIF Program by disseminating information to the public by providing links to the appropriate website(s) on the Brazos G website. Brazos G authorizes the Brazos G Chairman to respond with letters of collaborative support to Cameron, Stephenville, and others who may request participation during the fifth cycle of regional water planning.

Option 2. The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group supports the efforts of communities to develop flood studies pursuant to the Texas Flood Infrastructure Fund Category 1 Watershed Studies Program (FIF Program). However, the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group respectfully declines invitations to participate for the reason that flood planning is outside the scope of regional water planning."
