My name is Jake Hollingsworth and I am the Chief of Staff for Gulf Coast Water Authority. I would like to submit the following public comments for the Pre-Planning Public Input Meeting for the Sixth Cycle of Regional Water Planning Item 4.1.2:

- I request that the 2026 Brazos G Region Water Plan address restricting non-agricultural Brazos Alluvium well usage until such time it is determined pumping from Brazos Alluvium wells does not impact the availability of water in the Brazos River for downstream users.
- I request that the 2026 Brazos G Region Water Plan address the opportunity for collaboration among the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group, the Region H Water Planning Group, Brazos River Authority, and coastal wholesale providers to develop seawater desalination as a water portfolio option for the state of Texas.
