Subject: Brazos G Identification of WUGs for the Purposes of the 2026 Brazos G Plan

Dear Ms. Devlin:

As the Project Manager for the Technical Consultant team, I am submitting this memorandum on behalf of the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group (Brazos G RWPG). At its July 13, 2022 public meeting, the Brazos G RWPG approved for their Technical Consultant to coordinate with the TWDB and submit comments and revisions on the Draft Water User Group (WUG) List for the purposes of the 2026 Brazos G Water Plan. This submittal (and digitally attached workbook) documents the Brazos G RWPG's recommended revisions to the draft WUG information previously provided by TWDB.

The 2026 Brazos G Regional Water Plan will include municipal WUGs based upon the approach of utility-based planning. Consistent with the information provided by TWDB regarding the draft identification of potential municipal WUGs for Brazos G, seven new entities have been identified that meet municipal WUG criteria for facilities and private utilities, namely:

1. Bell County WCID 1;
2. Cade Lakes WSC;
3. City of Benjamin;
4. Hog Creek WSC;
5. Noack WSC;
6. S U N WSC; and
7. Westbound WSC

For the purposes of the 2026 Brazos G Water Plan, the Brazos G RWPG recommends the following revision be made to the name for one of these new WUGs:

Removal of "City of" from the draft name is consistent with the naming conventions used for other municipal WUGs within the Brazos G planning process.

Additionally, the draft information from TWDB included several suggested name changes for municipal WUGs within the Brazos G planning area, as indicated in the table below. These changes are approved by the Brazos G RWPG for the purposes of the 2026 Brazos G Water Plan, with no recommended revisions.
